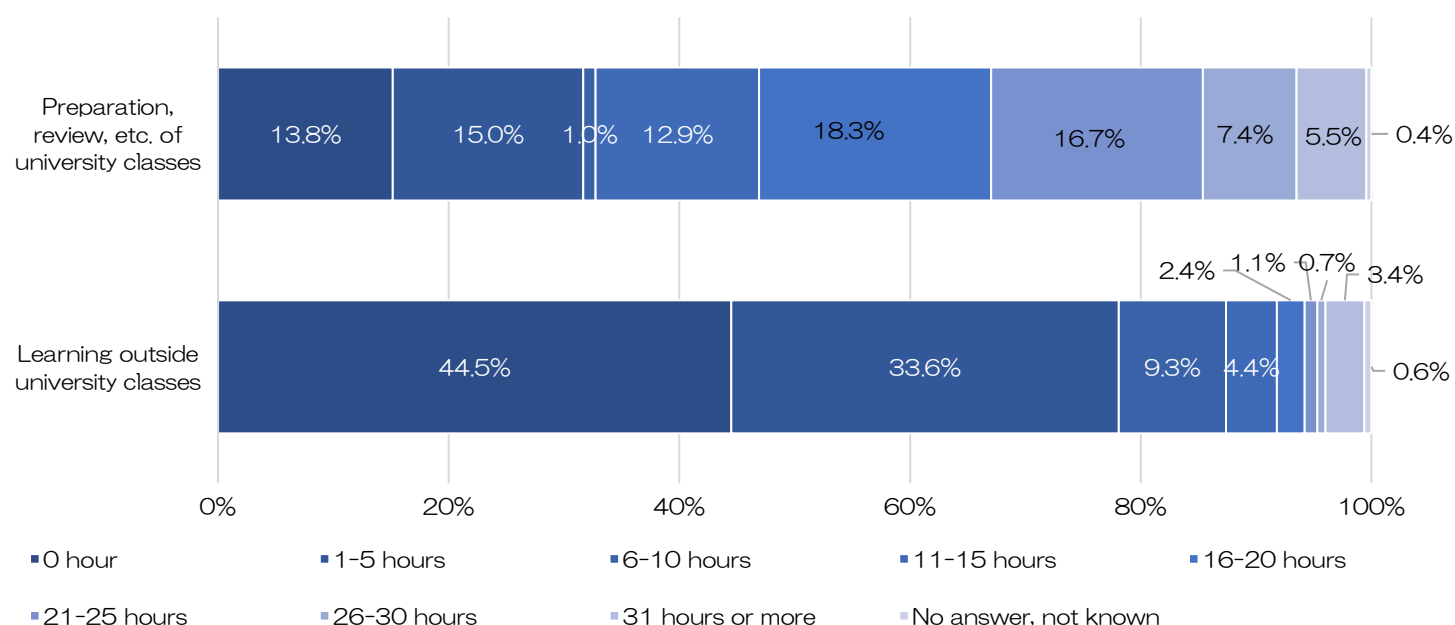


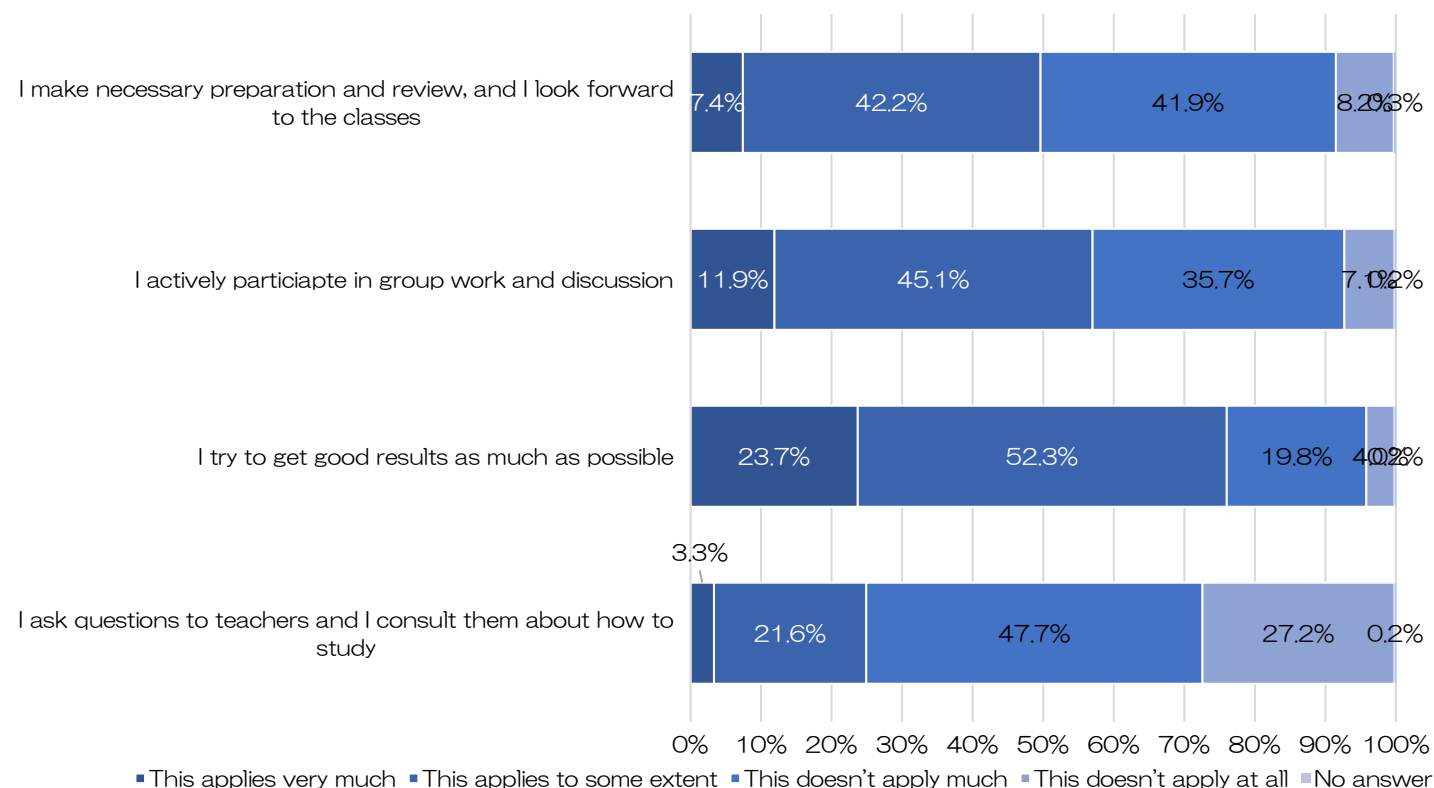

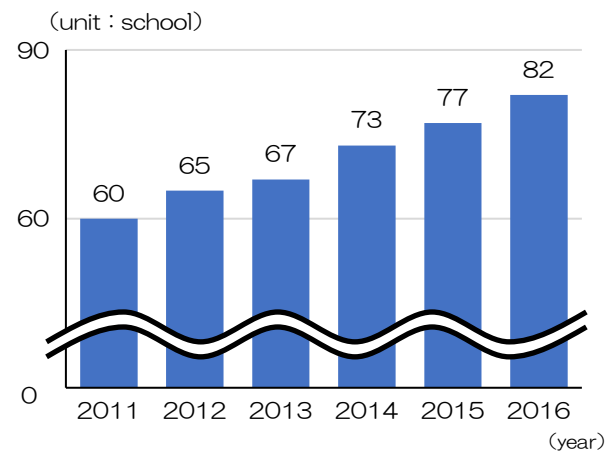
5-2. Learning behavior of national university students

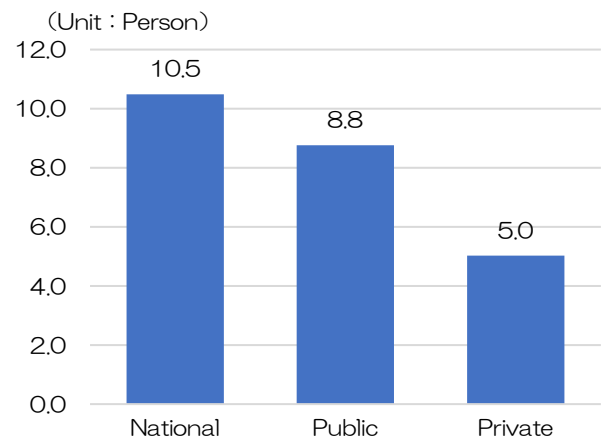

5-3. Number of national universities that have introduced the GPA system (strict grade assessment)



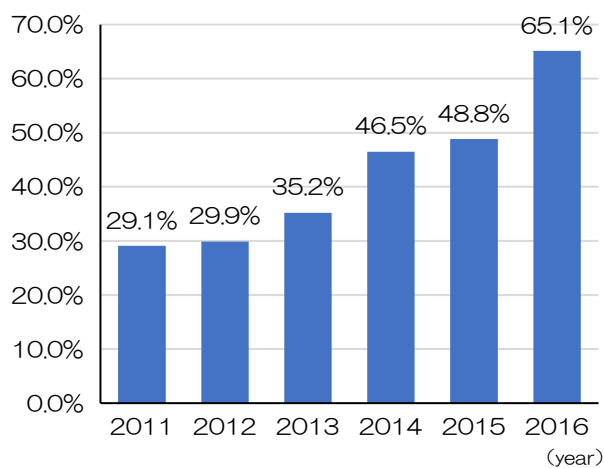

5-5. Number of faculty member per 100 students



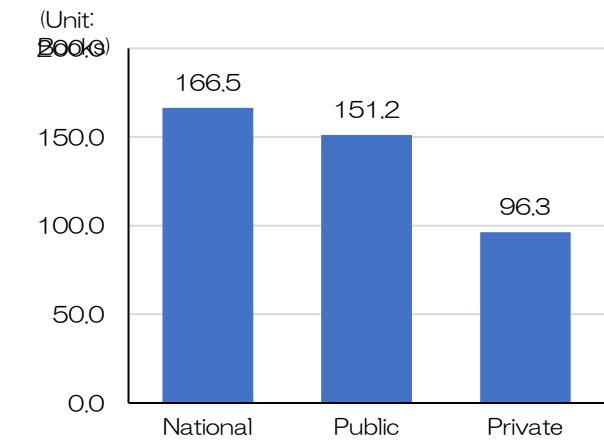
